Photo Descriptions

Slide 7:

Photo description: Under the tent, two people are seated at a table. At left, the DB man has his right arm on the table as he listens to his SSP tactually using his left hand.

Slide 11:

Photo description: Just left of center, the instructor sits facing away from the camera besides her DB friend, facing towards to camera, to demonstrate the conversational position while the group circles around the seated people.

Slide 13:

Photo description: Two women seated side-by-side communicate tactually.

Slide 14:

Photo description: Two DB women are seated side-by-side to communicate tactually.

Slide 16:

Photo description: At right, a DB woman crouches to talk with a seated DB woman, at left.

Slide 17:

Photo description: At the lower left corner, a sighted friend crouches to converse with two seated women, at the center and on the right.

Slide 19:

Photo description: At left, an SSP (facing away from the camera) and her DB client use pillows as back support while seated.

Slide 22:

Photo description: At right, the SSP rests her arms while her DB client maintains contact with her elbow for guidance.

Slide 24:

Photo description: The SSP rests her left arm but keeps contact with the DB person (at left, not pictured) using her right arm.

Slide 25:

Photo description: Two DB people, at left and at right, pause, put their coats between their legs, and resume conversation while a third person, at center, watches.

Slide 33:

Photo description: A DB man, his back to the camera, is in a store wearing a backpack.

Slide 34:

Photo description: Outside, by the shoreline, two women are conversing. On the left, a DB woman wears a shoulder bag, while at right, the second woman wears a handbag over her shoulder.

Slide 39:

Photo description: At left, an SSP guides the hand of a blind camper to a specific mark on a tactile map of the campground.
